Reasons for Removal: <u>Dead/Risk to park users</u>
Dates/duration of Removal Work: August 2023
Associated Closures/impacts from Tree Work: No closures/Tree drop zone will be coned off and monitored by Parks staff during removal.
Tree Replacement Plan: 1 Ohio Buckeye and 1 Plains Cottonwood will replace the dead Plains Cottonwoods in Fall 2023.

Reasons for Removal: The tree is dead, high risk to park users
Dates/duration of Removal Work: August 2023
Associated Closures/impacts from Tree Work: No closures. During removal, the tree drop zone will be coned off and monitored by Parks staff.
Tree Replacement Plan: An Ohio Buckeye will replace the Plains Cottonwood in Fall 2023.

Location of Tree Removal(s): Washington Park (east of pool)
Number and Species of Trees to Remove: 1 Globe Willow
Reasons for Removal: Massive decay at the base of co-dominant stems, high risk to park users, especially kids that climb the tree
Dates/duration of Removal Work: August 2023
Associated Closures/impacts from Tree Work: No closures/Tree drop zone will be coned off and monitored by Parks staff during removal.
Tree Replacement Plan: Tree replacement will be postponed until the Washington Park Revival Project design is completed. The project will include planting a variety of trees to enhance the park canopy health and aesthetics
