#### Dangerous Building update:

July 19, 2023 a case was opened for Dangerous Building on the west side of Casper. This location had a deceased owner with squatters having claimed rights to the residence. Numerous Police Calls, the lack of water and electricity to the structure only increased the unsanitary and unsafe living conditions.

The amount of junk litter and debris, as well as illegally running and connected generators made this home a high risk for fire.

After numerous delays, on Dec. 28<sup>th</sup>, 2023 a new owner had purchased the location, secured a licensed contractor, and renovation and rehabilitation had begun. This alleviated the City of Casper to proceed with demolition with associated costs.

On March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2024, a C/O (Certificate of Occupancy was issued by the Building Dept on this location.

Attached you will find before and after photographs of the residence. This was a positive outcome of a home that was renovated and will make someone a wonderful starter home.

The hard work across the board from the Building Dept, Fire Dept, Code Enforcement, Police Dept, Attorney's Office and neighbors has made this transformation a reality and positive addition to the community. The support from The City Manager, and Council has been paramount in moving forward in reduction of blight and criminal activity.

Our total expenditure to date on this location was \$5,838 which was for junk clean-up on the exterior, and boarding of the location, plus materials including mailings and postings. This number does not include personnel time.
