Owen Wister Exhibit Closes, Tom Carrigen Exhibit Opens at Fort Caspar Museum

Casper, Wyoming – Fort Caspar Museum announces a change in special exhibits. “The Virginian: Owen Wister’s Creation of the Great American Novel” will be available for viewing through Saturday, November 26th. The exhibit commemorates the 100th anniversary of the novel *The Virginian*. The exhibit is from the American Heritage Center in Laramie and was created from materials in the Owen Wister Papers.
