Exhibits Close at Fort Caspar Museum ***Let's Ride: Celebrating the Pony Express*** **and *An Eye on Wyoming: William Henry Jackson***

Casper, Wyoming – Two temporary exhibits at Fort Caspar Museum will close on Saturday, November 6th. “Let’s Ride: Celebrating the Pony Express” and “An Eye on Wyoming: William Henry Jackson” opened in November 2009.

“Let’s Ride: Celebrating the Pony Express” features artifacts commemorating the Pony Express during the 20th century. This year is the 150th anniversary of the establishment of the Pony Express. The exhibit highlights include a torch and mochila used during the 1996 Olympic Torch Relay by the National Pony Express Association, archaeological artifacts as well as collectibles. Take a trip down memory lane with the collectibles including movie posters, a record, ornaments, stamps, postcards, toys, a lunchbox, puzzles, books, a tea set and a box of Pony Express Peanut Clusters! This exhibit is fun for kids too! A special hands-on section allows kids to dress up like a rider and imagine they are on the trail. Several people and organizations have helped make this exhibit possible, including the Wyoming State Museum, Quackgrass Sally, Les Bennington and Jay Jensen.

“An Eye on Wyoming: William Henry Jackson” focuses on artist Jackson’s time in Wyoming with the Hayden Survey in 1870 through the 1930s. Photographs and paintings of events illustrate Jackson’s strong connections to the region. Did you know he made paintings of the Battle of Red Buttes and the Battle of Platte Bridge? Have you ever seen the photograph from the Historical Society picnic at Jackson Canyon (west of Casper)



from September 1927? Jackson’s impressions of Wyoming cover seventy years of exploration, changes, community and preservation. Don’t miss the chance to lay your eyes on Wyoming’s past!
