What is a docent? - A docent is someone who provides interactive learning experiences through tours, lectures, and hands-on activities as a volunteer.

What are the traits of a great docent? - They will possess a love of history, an enjoyment of youth, and must feel very comfortable speaking in front of the public, mainly schoolchildren.

What is the time commitment? - It involves one training session provided by Museum staff. You will be given tools you will need to effectively work with visitors, knowledge of site history, and tour objectives. Docents will give one tour (about 90 minutes) a week during the spring session, fall session, or both.
