### Opens New Traveling Exhibit

### “Fill ‘er Up!: Historic Wyoming Gas Stations”

Casper, Wyoming – Fort Caspar Museum is hosting a new traveling exhibit from the Wyoming State Museum in Cheyenne, WY. “Fill ‘er Up!: Historic Wyoming Gas Stations ” is open through March 27<sup>th</sup>. This exhibit examines the evolution of Wyoming gas station architecture from the early days of the 20th century to more recent times. Text and historic photographs examine the changing needs and interests of Wyoming communities and the selling of gasoline. From curbside gasoline sales, drive-in gas stations to full-service stations and convenience stores, this exhibit features historic photographs from Casper, Rawlins, Cheyenne, Greybull and many more Wyoming towns.

In conjunction with the exhibit, a special lecture is planned Saturday, February 6<sup>th</sup> at 3 pm. Join Heyward Schrock for “Rest and Refuel: Along Wyoming’s Lincoln Highway” to learn more about early automobile traffic in Wyoming through photographs, advertisements, postcards and more.
