## **Save History: Preserving Family Papers, Photos, and Computer Files**

Casper, Wyoming – History enthusiasts, family historians, and lovers of times past, mark your calendars! Fort Caspar Museum and the American Heritage Center in Laramie, WY are teaming up to offer a presentation on preserving family papers, photos and computers files. This program will take place on Friday, July 11<sup>th</sup> from 7:00 – 9:00 pm. Bring your materials for the hands-on portion of the presentation. However, there will not be appraisals of materials.

The Director of the American Heritage Center at the University of Wyoming, Mark Greene, will present information aimed at assisting any family historian with preserving papers, photos, and computer files. Mark will focus on inexpensive steps that anybody can take to ensure that their family collections will survive for years to come.

Green has been the director of the American Heritage Center since August of 2002. He began his career as archivist of Carleton College, followed by 11 years as the curator of manuscripts at the Minnesota Historical Society, and tenure as head of research center programs for the Henry For Museums in Dearborn, Michigan. Mark has published over a dozen articles on archival matters in the U.S., Canada, Sweden, Spain, and the U.K. He is a national workshop instructor in the archival field.
