Want to give a helping hand? Volunteer at Fort Caspar Museum

Casper, Wyoming – Want to give a helping hand? Volunteer at Fort Caspar Museum! People from all over the world visit our city and the museum. Would you like to meet them? Share a “hidden gem” and a piece of our past with them? If so, there are opportunities for you. Fort Caspar Museum is looking for volunteers to help at the Front Desk or as a Docent with school tours from May – September.

Fort Caspar Museum is a regional history museum whose mission is to collect, preserve, and exhibit materials related to the history of Fort Caspar, the City of Casper, Natrona County, and central Wyoming.

Front Desk Volunteers assist staff and the public from May to September. Volunteers greet visitors, ring up admissions and bookstore sales on the cash register, assist in re-stocking the bookstore, answer visitor questions regarding site history and area attractions, and answer the telephone. Staff provides training on all of these duties.

Docents or volunteer school tour guides help give tours to school students from around Wyoming. They lead tours of the fort buildings and museum gallery activities. Staff provides training about site history and how to work with students during the tours. Docents are asked to give one tour (about 2 hours) a week during the spring session, fall session or both.

We appreciate our volunteers. Benefits of volunteering at Fort Caspar Museum include recognition at the annual appreciation dinner and twenty (20) recorded volunteer hours entitle you to a free one-year individual membership in the Fort Caspar Museum Association. This membership provides free admission, special invitations to luncheons and activities, and a 15% discount in the bookstore.
