

Services Included

The following residential services are provided for the fee listed on the monthly water bill:

- Once a week trash collection
- Twice monthly pickup for extra trash
- A free Balefill pass once per month. The pass is good for one car, pick-up or 8 foot trailer load of garbage. For more details call 235-8246 or visit www.casperwy.gov.
- Free electronics recycling at balefill.
- Free disposal of household hazardous waste at the special waste and diversion facility at Balefill.
- Free disposal of leaves, grass clippings, and branches at the Balefill compost yard.
- Free recycling at 9 different depots.

- Additional dump
- Special Permit Service for residents with special needs
- Special Pickup
- Additional 95 - 100 gallon container

Holiday Information

Trash is not collected on Thanksgiving, Christmas or New Year's Days. On these holidays, collection will be delayed one day for all customers. For example, if Christmas is on a Wednesday, collection for Wednesday customers will be on Thursday; Thursday customers on Friday; and Friday customers on Saturday. Trash is collected on all other holidays, even if city offices are closed.

Extra Trash Guidelines

Extra trash is collected on the 1st and 3rd or 2nd and 4th trash days of the month. Trash must be placed following these guidelines:

- Three items or less.
- Each item must weigh less than 50 pounds.
- Brush or tree limbs must be cut into 5 foot lengths, bundled and tied.
- Lawn clippings/leaves should be bagged or boxed and securely closed.
- Small items must be bagged and securely tied closed.
- Placed no more than 24 hours prior to pickup.
- Placed at least 3 feet from the container. Do not place items against container or blocking container.

Grass clippings, leaves, sod, and branches may be taken to the compost facility at the Balefill for free! Hours are 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Saturday.



Recycling Depots

The City of Casper has 9 Recycling Depots:

- Balefill
- Kelly Walsh High School
- Meals on Wheels
- Rocky Mountain Discount Sports
- Sunrise Shopping Center
- Denis Dr. (by Shell Station on CY)
- North Casper Ball Fields
- Wal-Mart (Second Street)
- Paradise Valley pool

The depots have bins provided for office paper, #1 plastics, #2 plastics, newspaper, magazines, aluminum, glass, phone books and corrugated cardboard. The Balefill collects other metal items, rechargeable batteries, and electronics for recycling. Visit www.casperwy.gov for maps to depots.

- 1st and 3rd
- 2nd and 4th

Not collected

The following items cannot be placed in containers or for extra trash pick-up

- Dirt, sod, brick, concrete, & rock
- Lumber, drywall, shingles, plaster, & other construction materials
- Wood, plastic, & metal fencing & posts
- Vehicle parts & large metal items/furniture
- Paint, pesticides, household cleaners, & poisons
- Televisions, computers, gaming system, DVD players, & other electronic items
- Needles, urine, heavily blood-stained material, & Dead animal carcasses
- Tires (car, truck, bicycle, etc)
- Used oil, gas/fuel, antifreeze, & batteries
- Propane tanks
- Bicycles, lawn mowers, grills, & satellite dishes
- Furniture, appliances, & carpet
- Explosives, ammunition, & fireworks
- Hot ashes (*ashes may be wet down and bagged*)

Alley Access Service

Residents with alley access share 300 gallon containers, one per every three houses. Each resident is allowed to use 1/3 of the container. Containers are located on one side of the alley.



Curbside Service

Residents without alley access are provided one 90 gallon roll-out container per household.

Containers **should be:**

- Out at the curbside (in the gutter next to the curb) by **7:00 am** on collection day. Do not place out the night before collection.
- **6 feet** from obstructions such as parked vehicles, fences or mailboxes.
- Open facing the street (handle facing house).
- Removed by 6 p.m.

Help Prevent Litter

Litter detracts from neighborhood appearance & impacts the entire community. It is easy to prevent some types of litter:

- 1. Bag it.*** All trash must be bagged and securely tied or taped closed (city ordinance).
- 2. Close it.*** Make sure the lid closes on your trash can. Do not overfill your container.
- 3. Secure it.** All loads hauled by any vehicle must be either covered with a tarp or cloth and tied down or tied down using a cargo net, ropes, straps or bungee cords. Any load that is unsecured is assessed a fee (\$15 residential/\$50 commercial) at the Balefill.

** A \$15 non-compliance fee may be added to your monthly water bill for failure to bag or for overfilling*
