Changes to City Pool Passes and Daily Admission Fees

One 3 Month Aquatics Pass or any increment of a Casper Family Aquatic Center Pass is all that is needed for unlimited admission to Washington Pool, Mike Sedar Pool, Paradise Valley Pool, Marion Kreiner Pool and the Casper Family Aquatic Center. In the past, separate passes were needed for outdoor pools and the indoor facility. Passes are available for purchase at the Casper Recreation Center, 1801 East 4th Street. The Community Recreation Foundation provides financial assistance, if needed, toward the pass purchase.

A 3 Month Aquatics Pass is \$80 for adults (19 years and over), \$65 for teens (13-18 years), and \$50 for children (5-12 years). Up to two children four years old and younger swim free when accompanied by a paid adult admission. For those wishing to extend their swimming season by using the Casper Family Aquatic Center after the outdoor pools close, 6 month and annual Aquatics Passes are available.

If someone doesn't have a pass, daily admission is an option. Daily admission into the Casper Family Aquatics Center is \$6. Daily admission fees are \$4.50 for Mike Sedar and Paradise Valley and \$3.50 for Marion Kreiner and Washington Pools. A designated time for Adult Fitness Swim is offered at Paradise Valley and Washington Pools, Mondays through Fridays, from noon until 1:00 p.m. for \$2.

All City of Casper Pools are staffed with American Red Cross certified lifeguards. Multiple sessions of swim lessons and water exercise classes are held at various times and locations throughout the summer. Additionally, special events and activities will be held at the pools.
