It's Time to Move Recreational Vehicles Off of City Streets

Storing recreational vehicles on City streets is illegal

Casper, Wyoming (November 9, 2016) - Winter is fast approaching, and the City of Casper wants to remind citizens that it is illegal to store a recreational vehicle, which includes boats, camper trailers, horse trailers, etc., on the street for more than 5 days in any 30-day period. However, due to drifting/blowing snow, poor visibility, icy road conditions, and other winter hazards, it is particularly important for RV's to be removed from City streets during the winter months.

Therefore, the City of Casper Code Enforcement Department is asking residents to take the initiative and remove their recreational vehicles from City streets. RV's that remain on the street for more than 5 days may receive a notice of violation.
