Recommendation:

That Council, by minute action, proclaim and certify the results of the special election on Ordinance No. 15-13.

Summary:

A special election was held on November 3, 2015, for the purpose of submitting Ordinance No. 15-13 of the Casper Municipal Code entitled "An Ordinance Amending Certain Sections of Chapter 8.16 of the Casper Municipal Code, Pertaining to Smoking in Public Places" to the electors of the City of Casper for its adoption or rejection.

Section 22-23-808 of the Wyoming Statutes requires the governing body to meet not later than three days after the election in order to canvass the results of the election. Pursuant to this section, the Mayor has set a special meeting for this purpose on Wednesday, November 4, 2015. The Natrona County Clerk has been acting as the agent of the City in conducting this election, and will report the results of the election to the City Council on November 4, 2015.

A Proclamation and Certification of the results of this Special Election has been prepared for your review and approval by minute action once the results of the election have been reported by the Natrona County Clerk to the City of Casper.
