Incidents by Day of Week








First arriving CFD engine running emergent only







Ridgecrest Fire

This fire was the result of youth fire play, not unlike the many youth caused fires we respond to every month; the one big acceptance being the weather conditions and topography. The abnormal dryness and sustained high winds took a small fire and fanned it into an uncontrollable fast moving fire. The fire covered 33 acres and damaged numerous structures and residences on the northwest side of Ridgecrest. Many fire agencies across Natrona County responded as mutual aid to this fire and the combined effort saved many thousands of dollars in damages. The majority of fire damage to the properties along Ridgecrest that had defensible areas between the hillside and their yards sustained less damage. Keeping dry vegetation away from property can and most often will slow or stop fire from coming into contact with exposures.
