

COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
Casper City Hall – Council Chambers
October 13, 2015

Casper City Council met in special session at 4:30 p.m., Tuesday, October 13, 2015. Present: Cathey, Hopkins, Johnson, Miller, Mundell, Pacheco, Sandoval, Schlager and Mayor Powell.

Mayor Powell asked for a moment of silence for all those impacted by the recent fire in the Evansville/Cole Creek Road area.

Mayor Powell led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Following resolution read:

RESOLUTION NO. 15-277

A RESOLUTION SETTING THE DATE FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE ADOPTION OR REJECTION OF ORDINANCE NO. 15-13, AUTHORIZING A PROCLAMATION SETTING THE DATE OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION, THE LOCATIONS OF THE POLLING PLACES, AND NUMBER OF ELECTION JUDGES THEREFOR.

Councilman Mundell presented the foregoing resolution for adoption. Seconded by Councilman Johnson. City Manager Patterson provided a brief report.

Moved by Councilman Sandoval, seconded by Councilman Mundell, to, by minute action, suspend the Council Rules regarding the Monday noon deadline, as City offices were closed for Columbus Day, and citizens requesting to be placed on the agenda could not do so before the deadline. Motion passed.

Keith Goodenough, 120 E. 15th, and Paul Paad, 2781 Cherokee, addressed Council regarding the smoking ordinances.

After some discussion, a vote on the resolution resulted in all ayes. Motion passed.

Moved by Councilman Cathey, seconded by Councilman Hopkins, to, by minute action adjourn into the regularly scheduled work session. Motion passed.
