

Columbarium RFP – Amendment #1

Background

The City of Casper had originally released a Request for Proposal (RFP) for procurement and delivery of a columbarium unit at Highland Cemetery. Based on statements from the State of Wyoming Department of Health – Aging Division, the City of Casper has amended the RFP. These amendments are made to help strengthen the RFP and ensure that the best services and products are obtained for the City.

Summary of Changes to the RFP

- **Section f. – Compliance with State Law**
The current RFP states that full compliance must be met with state statutes 35-8-402(a)(i) through 35-8-402(a)(vii).
With new information from the State, we are striking the statutes stated above and hereby amending Section F as follows:

Section f.- Compliance with State Law

Please address Wyoming State Statute 35-8-402(a)(iii) -

That the foundation shall extend below the frost line and shall be of reinforced construction;

And 35-8-402(a)(viii) -

That the structure shall be so constructed as to insure its beauty, durability and permanence, as well as the safety, convenience, comfort and health of the community in which it is located, as dictated and determined at the time by modern mausoleum construction and engineering science.
