Casper, Wyoming – Fort Caspar Museum invites students from Kindergarten to Sixth grade to spring in to the past with “Adventure on the Plains.” Programs are scheduled Tuesday, March 11th through Friday, March 14th from 2:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. Each daily program will introduce a new topic relating to life on the newly settled frontier. On Tuesday, March 11th, listen to Jean Van Leeuwen’s *Going West*. Make a covered wagon and imagine the adventure moving west! Please bring an old shoe box from home for the craft activity. On Wednesday, March 12th, use your senses as you discover how to navigate the land like an early explorer. On Thursday, March 13th, listen to Paul Goble’s *Dream Wolf* and make a parfleche, a Northern Plains Indian bag. On Friday, March 14th, play like a pioneer child, participating in pioneer games, and making and eating snacks that were popular during the rush out west. The programs will be held in the new educational Multi-Use Room and Classroom.

All participating children must be accompanied by an adult. The program is free to participants, however regular admission fees will be charged for the Museum gallery.
