July 17th: *The Legend of Jimmy Spoon* by Kristiana Gregory

July 31st: *Doe Sia: Bannock Girl and the Handcart Pioneers* by Kenneth Thomasma

Each meeting will take place in the Multi-Use Room at Fort Caspar Museum. All program activities are free of charge. All children must be accompanied by an adult.
