

Recreation Division COVID-19 Safety Measures

The Recreation Division is taking extraordinary measures to clean and sanitize facilities to be compliant with the State of Wyoming COVID-19 orders. Our staff will clean areas after each use, as well as supply hand sanitizer for good hand hygiene. Class sizes will be limited and students will be expected to keep the recommended 6-foot distance from other students and teachers. There will be marks on the floor for easy distancing during classes. Some activities, such as Gymnastics classes or Basketball games, are not offered at this time because social distancing would be difficult, if not impossible.

The Casper Family Aquatic Center and other outdoor aquatic facilities will be closed for cleaning breaks every two hours. During this time all patrons will be asked to leave the pool, but will be allowed to stay in the facility. Patrons will not have to pay again if they would like to stay past the cleaning break.

Public Guidelines

- The public is asked to maintain 6 feet distance between one another, even while swimming. The public is asked to observe all posted signs and to be patient due to the limited number of occupants allowed in all facilities.
- Please be aware that minors will need to have their parents sign a City of Casper Recreation Minor Participant Record form for daily participation at all City recreation facilities including the Casper Recreation Center, Aquatics Center, and Casper Ice Arena when it reopens in November. This document will attest, by a parent or guardians' signature that the child has not had exposure to any person with COVID-19 during the previous 14 days and that he/she is not experiencing, and has not experienced for the last 14 days, any of the symptoms of COVID-19. This document is provided at all facilities and is also available on our web site.
- Likewise, all adults entering a facility will be asked to sign a participant record stating they have not been exposed to any person with COVID-19 during the previous 14 days and are not experiencing any symptoms.
- Children under the age of 18 participating in classes or camps will have their temperatures taken upon entering and will not be allowed to stay if temperature is above 100 degrees.

Staff Guidelines

- Staff continues to clean and disinfect high traffic touch areas such as; doors, counter tops, table tops, weight & cardio equipment, rest rooms & locker rooms, sports equipment and supplies.
- All staff are required to wear masks in public areas.
- All staff are required to take their temperatures before their shifts and stay home if they are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms.
