That Council allow the Casper Rotary Club to work with City staff to install a bouldering park at Crossroads Park.

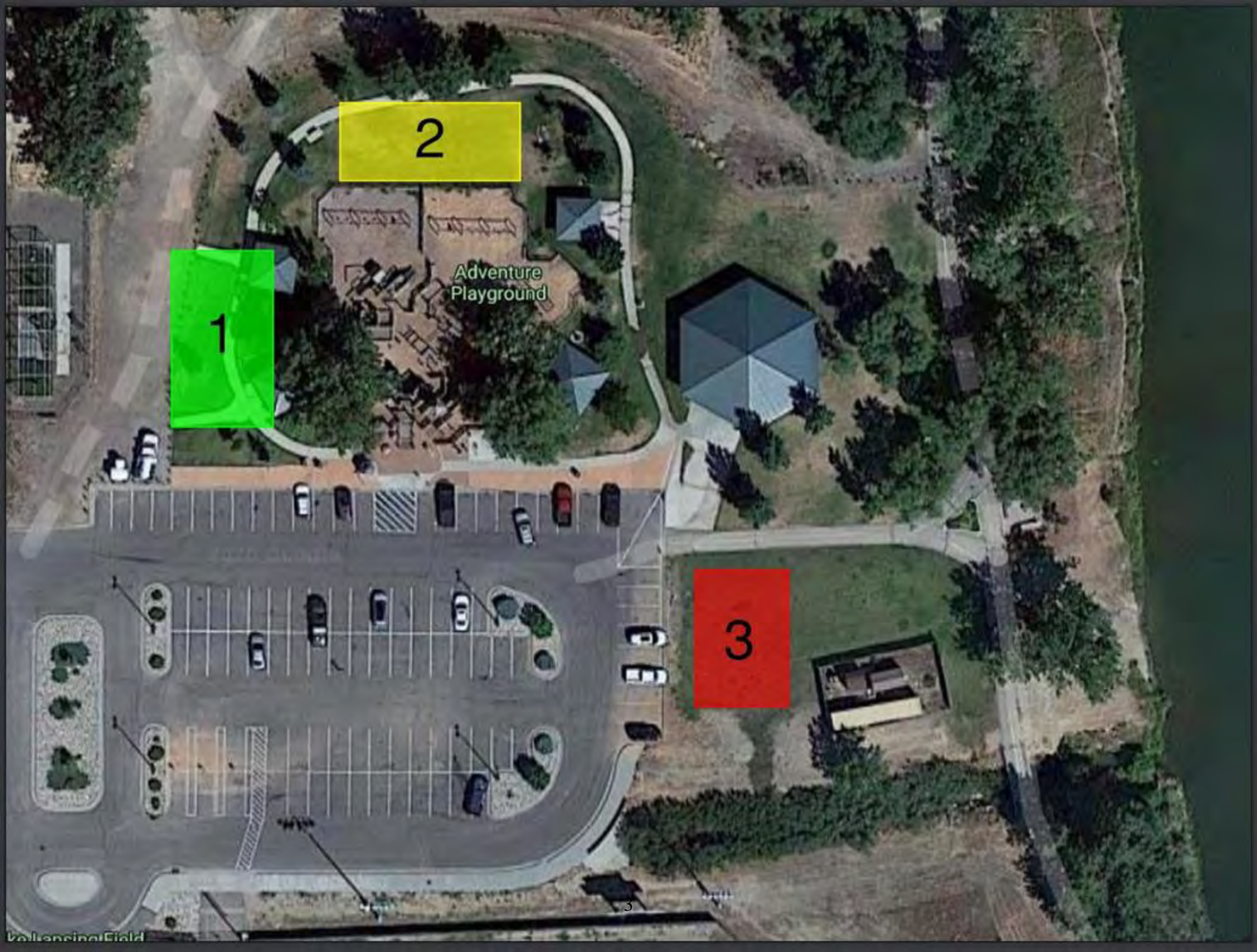
Summary
The City of Casper has been approached by the Casper Rotary Club to install a bouldering park within Crossroads Park. Rotary and City staff have discussed conceptual ideas up to this point. A design is very close to completion.

The Rotary Club wishes to gift the design, physical infrastructure and installation of the bouldering park to the City of Casper. At that point, the City would be responsible for the care and maintenance of the park in perpetuity.

Since it is a modification to a City Park, Council direction is requested.
